Bynum Fanyo Utilities is pleased to submit our proposal for Leachate Dredging from the Leachate Collection Pond. Bynum Fanyo Utilities Inc. is a local wastewater operation and maintenance company located in Bloomington. Bynum Fanyo Utilities operates over 20 wastewater plants in Monroe, Brown, Lawrence, Owen, Greene, Daviess and Sullivan counties.

Summary of Proposal/Statement of Familiarity with the Scope of Work

Bynum Fanyo provided a certified operator for the landfill wastewater treatment plant for the first year of operation. Bynum Fanyo will be partnering with Todd Septic Service for this project which gives our team experience and expert knowledge of the wastewater and leachate collection pond functions at the landfill. Bynum Fanyo's crews will be managed by Jeff Farmer whose is a Class IV IDEM licensed operator familiar with the regulations governing the disposal of leachate and sediment from the collection pond. As previously mentioned Bynum Fanyo will partner with Todd Septic Service an Indiana licensed septic hauler to transport the leachate.

Proposed Work Schedule / Timeframe

Bynum Fanyo crews will utilize pressure washers and gas powered pumps to move the sediment to the loading area at the end of the leachate collection basin for removal by



Todd Septic Service. Todd Septic Service will pump from the loading area into a septic hauling truck and then transport the leachate, sludge and sediment to the Ellettsville treatment plant for disposal. Removal of the leachate, sludge and sediment will be completed within a 21-day timeframe between July 1, 2017 and August 31, 2017.
